## *NativeEnergy*

**Presidio** is pleased to announce that it is partnering with *NativeEnergy* to offset all of the CO<sub>2</sub> that will be produced in 2006 as a result of business travel and energy use at our offices – an estimated 207.7 tons. We are taking this action as a means of addressing our contribution to global warming, one of the most pressing environmental and social issues of our time.

With our purchase of CO<sub>2</sub> offsets, we are helping build a new Native American renewable energy project. We support the Rosebud Sioux tribe, which intends to build the Rosebud St. Francis Wind Farm in South Dakota. When “our” wind project is completed, it will displace dirty energy sources and keep CO<sub>2</sub> out of the air on our behalf.

[NativeEnergy](#) offsets the climate impacts of energy use for businesses, homeowners and for events such as the Green Festivals and music tours by the Dave Matthews Band, REM and others. How does *NativeEnergy* offset CO<sub>2</sub>? By enabling its clients to help build new wind farms and farm methane digesters owned and operated by Native Americans and by family dairy farmers. By purchasing a share of the renewable energy credits these projects are estimated to generate over their operating lives, clients bring critical up-front funding to them when they need it the most, helping them get financed and built.
